ATSC SCHOLARSHIP SPOTLIGHT

Recent Graduate Jada Smith & Senior Kelly Neighbour Recieve Scholarships



Jada Smith, who was a First Honor graduate (BS in atmospheric sciences) of UGA in Spring 2023, is the lone recipient of the 2023 <u>June Bacon-Bercey Scholarship</u> from the American Geophysical Union (AGU), the world's largest professional society devoted to the geophysical sciences. This scholarship is named after the first female broadcast meteorologist in the U.S. (and the first African-American broadcast meteorologist), who personally endowed the first version of this scholarship. Jada is the 2nd student honored with this scholarship since it was restarted.

Jada is using this scholarship to support her work toward a Master's degree in emergency management from Millersville University.



Kelly Neighbour, who is a senior at UGA triple majoring in atmospheric sciences and geography (B.S. & A.B.), is the recipient of a Senior Named Scholarship from the American Meteorological Society. She won the Naval Weather Service Association Scholarship. Kelly is pursuing the Double Dawgs program in Atmospheric Sciences and Geography. She is the 11th recipient of an AMS undergraduate scholarship in the history of our atmospheric sciences program. This is also the sixth year in a row that UGA has had a winner of an undergraduate scholarship from the AMS.

In addition to triple-majoring, Kelly is currently working towards an undergraduate GIS certificate and plans to enter the DoubleDawgs program shortly.

Interesting Stats about UGA and Undergraduate Scholarships from the AMS

- Out of the 70 different colleges and universities whose students have won
 undergraduate scholarships from the AMS since 2018, only two universities, UGA and
 the University of Oklahoma, have had winners in each of the past six years.
- In terms of the number of AMS undergraduate scholarships, UGA students have earned 7 in the past six years, and this is tied for 4th most out of the 70 schools, behind only OU, Penn State, and Cornell, and tied with Florida State University. OU and Penn State are the two largest meteorology programs in the nation, with at least 4 times more undergraduates than UGA's program; and Cornell is the only Ivy League school with an atmospheric sciences program.
- All seven of the UGA recipients are women, and three are African-American or biracial women.






